KEY AREAS

Reuther Park

Bring a picnic blanket, grab some takeaway from nearby vendors and sit down to enjoy lawn games and live music by Doghouse Collective and Burke & Wise.

Town Square

Join Roller Skate Margs for a spin in the car-park behind Margaret River Gourmet Meats, next to the Fearn Ave Festival Precinct.

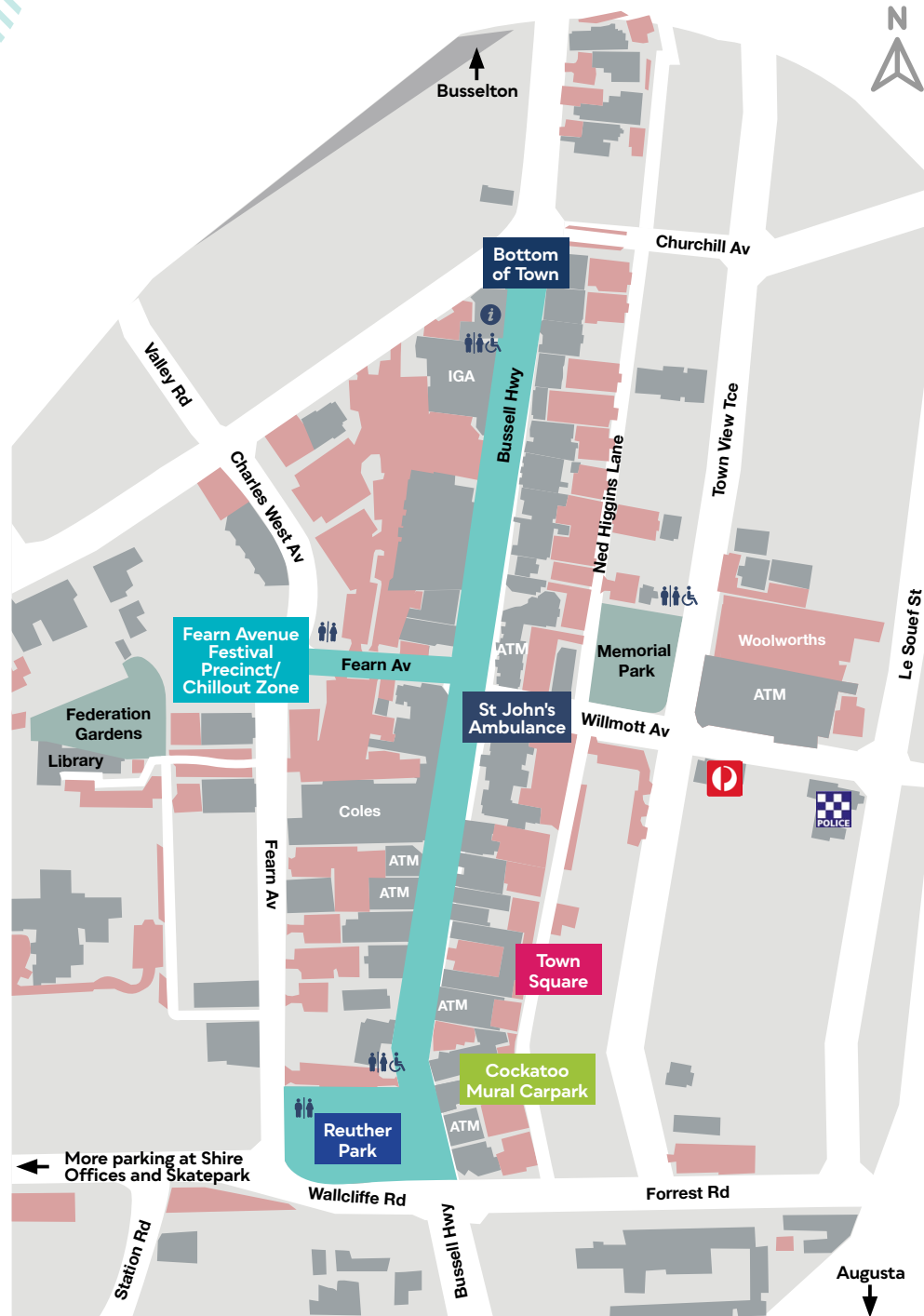
Bottom of Town

Share the love with your favourite local businesses by taking a browse, or purchase food on the night from one of the restaurants, pubs or bars. Some will be offering a take-away option so you can continue wandering, as well as alfresco dining out the front of their venue to take in all the action from a seated spot.

Parking and road closures

Bussell Highway will be closed off from Tunbridge Street to Wallcliffe Road from 11am to 11pm on Friday 29 January to allow us plenty of time for setting up the event. Please note, you will not be able to park on the street from 6am on the event date. Any cars left on the street after 11am will not be able to be driven out and may need to be towed away, so please take care that morning (and the night before) with your planning.
